Alberta's water policies in relation to land use will impact future generations. This session will **explore** the critical links between land and water policies both within our province, and around the world.




#### **SOCIETY**

#### DR. SARA SCHERR IS THE KEYNOTE SPEAKER FOR LAND USE 2018 HELD AT THE WESTIN EDMONTON ON MAY 30-31, 2018.

Dr. Scherr is a renowned agricultural and natural resource economist. She is a prominent voice globally in promoting the restoration of degraded agricultural lands for food security and rural livelihoods, and a leading innovator in integrated landscape management. Dr. Scherr is an expert in the economics of sustainable agriculture and agroforestry and the design of payments to farmers and farming communities for ecosystem stewardship. She founded EcoAgriculture Partners in 2002, and in 2011 co-founded the global Land-scapes for People, Food and Nature Initiative, which she now chairs.
